

2019 UArctic Rectors Forum Call for Poster Presentations Proposals



Trent University is re-issuing its Call for Poster Presentations Proposals for the 2019 University of the Arctic (UArctic) Rectors Forum, being hosted at Trent University on August 19 – 21, 2019. This forum provides a unique opportunity for students of UArctic member institutions to network with the faculty and executives, and to present their education related research projects. Undergraduate and graduate students are asked to submit poster presentation abstracts by the submission deadline: **May 31, 2019**.

The Rectors Forum poster session is intended to highlight posters that feature research in topics relevant to Northern Education, including: preliminary results, completed studies, summaries of relevant published research (for which you are the author), and position papers. The aim of the poster session is to facilitate dissemination of student research results to the broader community of Arctic leadership.

Submissions are welcome from students of any rank. Selected student posters will be on display throughout the duration of the Forum, and there will be a dedicated time for conference attendees to view the posters.

Submission Process:

In order to submit a poster presentation for consideration, please submit to uarctic@trentu.ca by the deadline.

Selected proposals will be offered a **\$500 CAD Travel Supplement**, which can be applied to any costs (travel, accommodation, registration fees, etc.) of attending the forum, or the associated excursion, in August.

Important Dates:

- Poster Proposals submission deadline: **Friday May 31, 2019 by 11:59 pm EST**
- Notification of decision to include poster: Friday June 14, 2019
- Forum Registration deadline: August 9, 2019

If the poster is accepted, the presenting author is expected to attend the 2019 UArctic Rectors Forum and to participate in the parallel student forum. Posters should be mailed to Trent University prior to the forum start date in order to be on display for the full duration of the forum. Selected authors will be requested to submit a 300-word abstract of their presentation to be included within the Forum Program.
