Proposal: The Executive Committee (Toyon) proposes that the Assembly make the following decisions:

- b) The Assembly accepts the nomination and elects **Birgitta Bergvall-Kåreborn** as member of the Board of UArctic for a three-year term (2022-2025).

Background:

The members of the Board are elected by the Assembly from slates of nominees prepared by the Nominations Committee. Nominations may also be made by any member representative at any Assembly in which a Board election takes place. In Board elections, the aim shall be to seek a regional distribution of members, where at least one member shall be from an Arctic Indigenous people within the Circumpolar North.

On candidate evaluations: UArctic's Nominations Committee members discussed strategies for filling vacancies, identified existing gaps and needs, and invited identified individuals. Following an evaluation of potential candidates, Committee members prepared a final slate of the following two nomination candidates. The Nominations Committee decided to leave three vacancies open in the Board.

Nominated Candidates:

Aaja Chemnitz Larsen Greenlandic politician from the Inuit Ataqatigiit. Member of the Folketing, Chair

of Arctic Parliamentarians (SCPAR) and chair of the Greenlandic Committee. Received the Dialogue Award from Denmark's Democratic Festival in Denmark

in 2021. Larsen – CV and bio.

Birgitta Bergvall-Kåreborn Vice-Chancellor of the Luleå University of Technology. Has long experience of

Board memberships in different organizations related to Luleå region and its development. Esteemed scholar in the field of informatics and systems science.
